

Please pay close attention to the following process. The timelines are different for the girls and boys applicants.

You **MUST** adhere to the following steps to be eligible for an award this year:

- Your materials must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 5, 2021 (girls) and June 21, 2021 (boys).
- Your materials must be submitted by email to the appropriate address: bourboncountygirlsfund@gmail.com OR bourboncountyboysfund@gmail.com
- Late or incomplete applications or applications sent to the wrong location will not be considered as eligible.
- If you are a first year applicant, you must provide a completed application, your high school transcript, and proof of enrollment at your school. If you already have your schedule complete, provide it as well. If you fail to provide a completed application or the required materials, you may not be awarded any monies.
- If you are a returning applicant, you must provide a completed application, your current college transcript of grades (your last semester must be a 2.0 g.p.a. or higher), and your schedule for the Fall Semester or proof of enrollment at a different school.
- Once your materials have been submitted, you will receive further information on how to schedule your interview. Interviews for all girls will be conducted via Zoom on either June 8 or 9, 2021. Interviews for returning boys applicants will be conducted on June 23, 2021 in person at the Courthouse. No interviews are needed for first year boys applicants.
- Awards of scholarship monies will be determined in late July.
- Any funds awarded will be sent directly to your school in one check in July or August.
